

Technology Centre CAS takes pleasure in inviting you to THE APPLICANTS' ON-LINE WORKSHOP ON HOW TO WRITE A COMPETITIVE PROPOSAL FOR MARIE SKŁODOWSKA-CURIE ACTIONS INDIVIDUAL FELLOWSHIPS?

The interactive on-line workshop will be focused on practical aspects of proposal writing. The workshop is open to the researchers from any disciplines who are currently preparing a MSCA IF proposal for the call 2020 and are in contact with their future host institution/supervisor regarding their concrete work plan.

There will be a plenary morning session where conditions for participation will be reminded, Evaluation criteria will be described in detail including panel specificities and frequent strengths and weaknesses from Evaluation Summary Reports will be presented.

In the afternoon session, the participants will have choice to join one of the three groups according to the scientific areas they had selected in the registration form (1. Physical Sciences and Engineering, 2. Life Sciences, 3. Social Sciences and Humanities). The evaluators will give general feedback on the CVs and abstracts received by the deadline stated below. The participants will have the opportunity to discuss a successful MSCA IF proposal with its principal investigator who will share useful tips and recommendations.

To maximize the impact and effectiveness <u>the afternoon session is open only to</u> <u>the researchers who will send their CVs and abstracts till 5 June 2020</u>. To attend the afternoon workshop the applicants are required to send a CV (max. 5 pages) and a short abstract of the proposal (max. 2 000 characters) according to the instructions in the Guide for Applicants¹ using the MSCA-IF-2020 call template.

Please send your CV and abstract in one Word document to Ms. Lenka Sechterova (<u>sechterova@tc.cz</u>). All materials will be considered confidential.

The links to the on-line workshop will be sent only to the registered participants no later than on 17 June 2020.

The event will be held in English. Translation will not be provided.
