DISCUSSION

Synergies in funding of research and innovation in Europe were one of the priorities of the Czech presidency of the Council of the EU (CZ PRES) in the second half of 2022. As an outcome of the presidency conference dedicated to this topic, the Prague declaration was endorsed by all member states. During the CZ PRES the European Commission presented the Commission Notice on Synergies between Horizon Europe and ERDF programmes.

Where do we stand today in the implementation of synergies? How well do research funding organizations and beneficiaries manage to align with the Commission Notice? How many points of the Prague declaration are being treated? How can we work closely to encourage the realization of the Prague declaration?

The aim of the meeting is to present news and progress in the field of synergies from the Presidency, domestic Czech perspective as well as the European Commission perspective. Discussion on the next pragmatic steps stemming from the Prague declaration shall take place.
